The Summer months have been very busy for both Friends of Alalay and the street children themselves.

I have been to a number of important events, including: a Parliamentary working lunch with a visiting Bolivian Parliamentary delegation to discuss street children, and then a joint welcome reception for the same delegation and others in the Houses of Parliament. Both were co-ordinated by the British Group of the Inter-Parliamentary Union. Later the same week I attended a Latin American Charities Forum organized by the LATA Foundation, and I recently enjoyed a party hosted by the Bolivian Embassy for Bolivia's 188th Anniversary of Independence. These events were a great way to meet several key decision makers and discuss challenges and ideas for the future. They have opened up a number of interesting possibilities – watch this space! I am thankful to all the organizers for inviting me to participate.

Despite many difficulties, all of our projects in Santa Cruz are progressing well, with the Prevention House programme to support local families



proving particularly effective. The following brief summary comes from one mother, helped by Alalay to keep her family together: "My current relationship with Alalay is very good. I have learned to value my family and they me. Much of this has been achieved by helping us to communicate better with each other".



The Alalay children have also been having an active time at a recent "Winter camp" where children from each of the welcome centres came to the aldea for many teambuilding activities, games and good food!

We are pleased to announce that we have just received the final copy of a full-length DVD of our March 1<sup>st</sup> fundraising concert with world-renowned cellist Michael Jones.
